**IMPORTANT Donation Guidelines:** Due to the hospital's infection prevention and control guidelines and space constraints, only certain items can be accepted. Please understand that for reasons of safety and privacy, donors cannot deliver gifts personally to patients and access to the Alberta Children's Hospital remains limited.

All items must be **brand new, without gift wrap, in original packaging** and:

- Be easy to disinfect (should have hard surfaces like plastic, vinyl, varnished/painted wood, metal)
- Come from a smoke-free, pet-free environment
- Be free of corporate branding and personal messaging
- Be sturdy, well-built, non-breakable and able to withstand a lot of use
- Be safe (no sharp edges, no small pieces for infant and toddler toys, made of non-toxic materials)
- Be non-aggressive (no toy weapons, no violent action figures)

Please note we are **unable** to accept:

- Used or previously owned items
- Stuffed toys taller than 12 inches
- Toy kitchens and playsets or large rideable cars and trucks
- Food products, dietary supplements or beverages
- Large quantities of the same item (10+)
- Homemade cards and personal notes
