All items must be **brand new, without gift wrap, in original packaging** and:

- Easy to disinfect (should have hard surfaces like plastic, vinyl, varnished/painted wood, metal)
- Come from a smoke-free, pet-free environment
- Free of corporate branding and personal messaging
- Sturdy, well-built, non-breakable and able to withstand a lot of use
- Safe (no sharp edges and made of non-toxic materials)
- Non-aggressive (no toy weapons, no violent action figures)

Please note we are **unable** to accept:

- Used or previously owned items
- Food products, dietary supplements or beverages
- Homemade cards and personal notes
